CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The Department of Informatics and Telematics, according to the Decision no. 213/02.04.2026 of the Assembly of the School of Digital Technology invites applications from prospective postgraduate students to submit an expression of interest for admission to the Master's Degree Programme (M.Sc.) entitled "Advances in Computer Science and Information Systems", with the following specializations:

- i) Data Science and Artificial Intelligence
- ii) Cloud and Edge Computing
- iii) Information Systems Administration and Digital Transformation

The program offers both full-time and part-time study options. The total number of available positions is sixty (60).

Eligible applicants include graduates of Departments with academic backgrounds related to Informatics, Telematics and Computer Science, as well as graduates of Science Schools, or Polytechnic Schools. from Greek Higher Education Institutions or equivalent foreign institutions,

Required Documents:

- ✓ Copies of academic degrees. Final-year students may also apply and be evaluated, but final admission is contingent upon obtaining their degree before the commencement of the program. For graduates of foreign Universities, the procedures stipulated by applicable Greek legislation apply.
- ✓ Copies of official transcripts for all undergraduate (and any postgraduate) studies, indicating the final degree grade and details of the thesis or dissertation if applicable.
- ✓ Proof of English language proficiency, evidenced by relevant certificates. For Greek citizens, level "B2" is mandatory, which can be certified either by the State Certificate of Language Proficiency or an equivalent language certification. Alternatively, proficiency can be demonstrated by a certificate of prior studies at a recognized English-speaking institution.
- ✓ Up to two (2) letters of recommendation.
- ✓ Detailed curriculum vitae (CV) and a brief statement of academic and research interests, including the reasons for applying to the programme.
- ✓ Abstract of undergraduate or diploma thesis (if completed or in progress).
- ✓ Copies of scientific publications (if any).

- ✓ Copy of both sides of the national identity card.
- ✓ Any additional supporting material the applicant considers relevant to strengthen their application.

The final evaluation and ranking of candidates will consider the following criteria:

- Overall degree grade and relevance of the academic background. For candidates who have not yet graduated, performance in completed courses and the number of successfully completed courses are considered.
- Performance in undergraduate courses relevant to the chosen specialization.
- Performance in the undergraduate thesis (where applicable).
- Results in English language proficiency certifications.
- Research activity (e.g., publications, conference presentations), where applicable.
- Relevant professional experience.
- Personal interview.

Duration of Studies:

According to the Programme's Study Regulations:

- Full-time study: 2 academic semesters, with the Master's thesis carried out during the summer period, allowing completion of studies by September. The maximum duration of study is 4 semesters.
- Part-time study: minimum duration of 4 semesters and maximum of 8 semesters. The Master's thesis may be assigned during the summer period prior to the beginning of the second year.

Tuition Fees and Scholarships:

The postgraduate programme requires tuition fees amounting to **€2,800** for the entire duration of studies.

Merit-based scholarships are awarded to top-performing full-time students in each specialization and semester, covering part of the tuition fees.

Selected candidates, after completing their enrollment, have the right to submit a tuition fee exemption request after the beginning of the academic year, in accordance with the provisions of the applicable legislation.
